### **Subject: Salmonella typhimurium in Peanut Butter**

474 cases of Salmonella typhimurium have been linked to peanut butter and products containing peanut paste in 43 states in the USA.

The US Food and Drugs Administration and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency have recalled the affected products.

There are no associated cases in the UK but the Food Standards Agency has issued a product recall as a precaution.

Caterers, shops and manufacturers that sell or use peanut butter products from the USA are asked to check the list of affected products and take them off sale.

Consumers are advised not to eat the affected products and to check the FDA and CFIA websites for the list of foods.
