**Subject:** Recall of Irish Pork

The Food Standards Agency have issued a food alert recalling Irish Pork affected by low level contamination with Dioxin. This has come from contaminated animal feed. Meat from 17 processing plants are affected. Some of the pork has been distributed to a company in East Sussex who may supply businesses in Wealden. The Public Protection Team in Wealden are working with other Local Authorities to identify who the affected pork has been sold to. As soon as we have this information we will contact the businesses that received it and deal with them directly.
